

SAFETY FIRST: CONVEYOR SAFETY REMINDERS

Conveyors are essential to our operations, but they come with safety risks like any mechanical and electrical equipment. With multiple moving parts, everyone working near them must understand and follow safety protocols.

Top Conveyor Safety Tips:

Stay Off the Conveyor - Do not

climb, sit, stand, walk, crawl, ride, or touch conveyors-zero tolerance.

Machine Guards Matter - Conveyor guards are there for your safety. Report any missing or damaged guards to onsite leadership. If a guard isn't functioning correctly, shut the machine down and have it inspected before continuing work.

Dress for Safety - Loose clothing, jewelry, or anything that could get caught in equipment is not allowed.

- · Wear well-fitted, buttoned, or zippered clothing.
- · Long hair must be tied back and secured under your hard hat.
- Safety vests must be 5-point breakaway
